Uklad opredeljujejo prevladujoča družinska kultura, odnos do okolice, način, kako se ljudje, ki pripadajo ukladu, zavedajo svoje preteklosti in gradijo svojo prihodnost, kako dojemajo svoje otroke, v kakšnem odnosu so s svojim ozemljem in sosedi, kako ravnajo s svojo in tujo lastnino, kako delajo ter kako preživljajo svoj prosti čas.

Predavateljica bo razpravljala o pristopu k ohranjanju kulturne dediščine v Republiki Moldaviji, ki temelji na ukladu in je bil razvit v okviru programa "Ruski strokovnjaki na prošnjo" v skladu s Partnerskim okvirnim sporazumom med Vlado Ruske federacije in Razvojnim programom Združenih narodov.

## An *uklad*-based approach to protection and sustainable development of cultural heritage in Chisinau, Moldova

An *uklad* is a persistent way of life / mode of activity which has a spatial expression. The ways *uklads* exist in the city differ according to the type of a city (e.g. capital city, a regional administrative center or a small town). An *uklad* is characterized by the prevalent family culture, by its attitude to the surrounding space, by the manner in which people belonging to the *uklad* are aware of their past and construct their future, by how they perceive their children, how they interact with their territory and their neighbors, how they own their property and treat others' property, and by how they work and spend their leisure time.

Irina Irbitskaya will discuss the *uklad*-based approach to preservation of cultural heritage in the Republic of Moldova, as elaborated in her report for Agency for Inspection and Restoration of Monuments of Moldova supported by UNDP Moldova within the framework of Russian Experts on Demand Programme.

*Irina Irbitskaya is an architect and urban planner. She is a director of Center of Urban Competence at the Russian Presidential Academy of National Economy and Public Administration (RANEPA) with the expertise in housing projects and urban development and planning advancement. She is a co-founder of the international project Doktor Gorodov.
